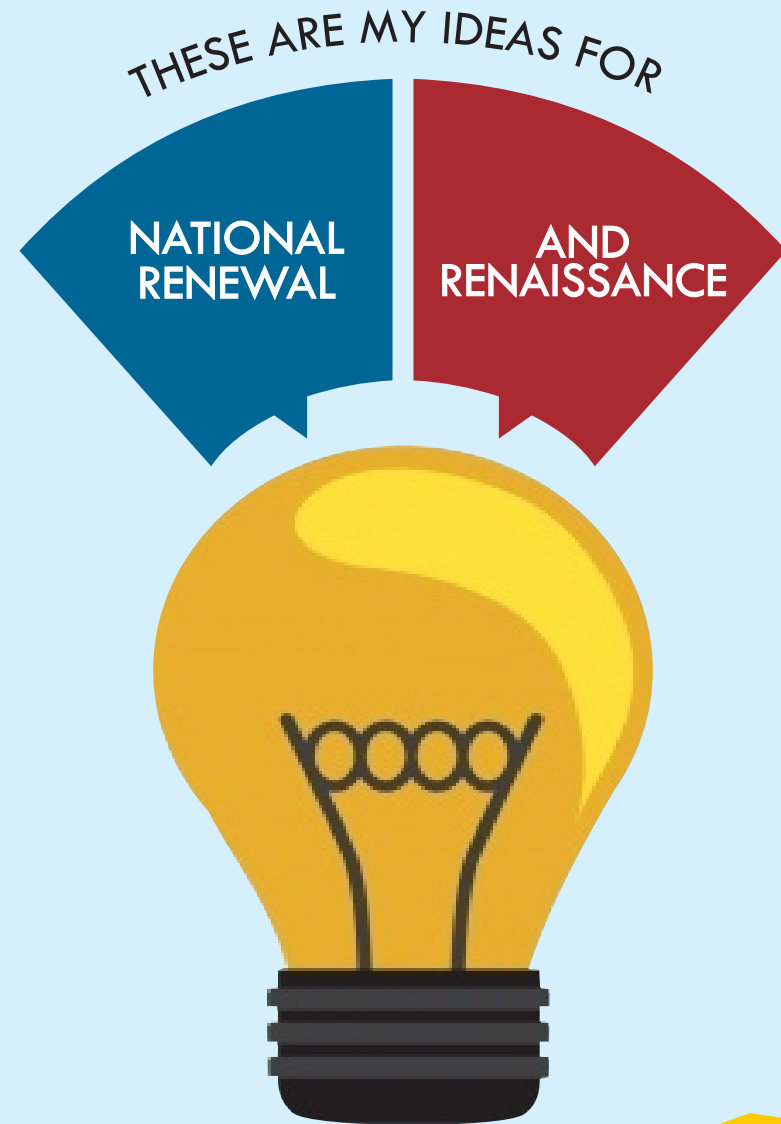

## CORE ACHIEVEMENTS AND PROJECTIONS (SUMMARY)

- TAKE 70MILLION PEOPLE OUT OF CRASS POVERTY IN 4 YEARS
- REDUCE THE SIZE OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT BUT STRENGTHEN LOCAL GOVERNANCE WITHIN THE AMBIT OF FEDERALISM

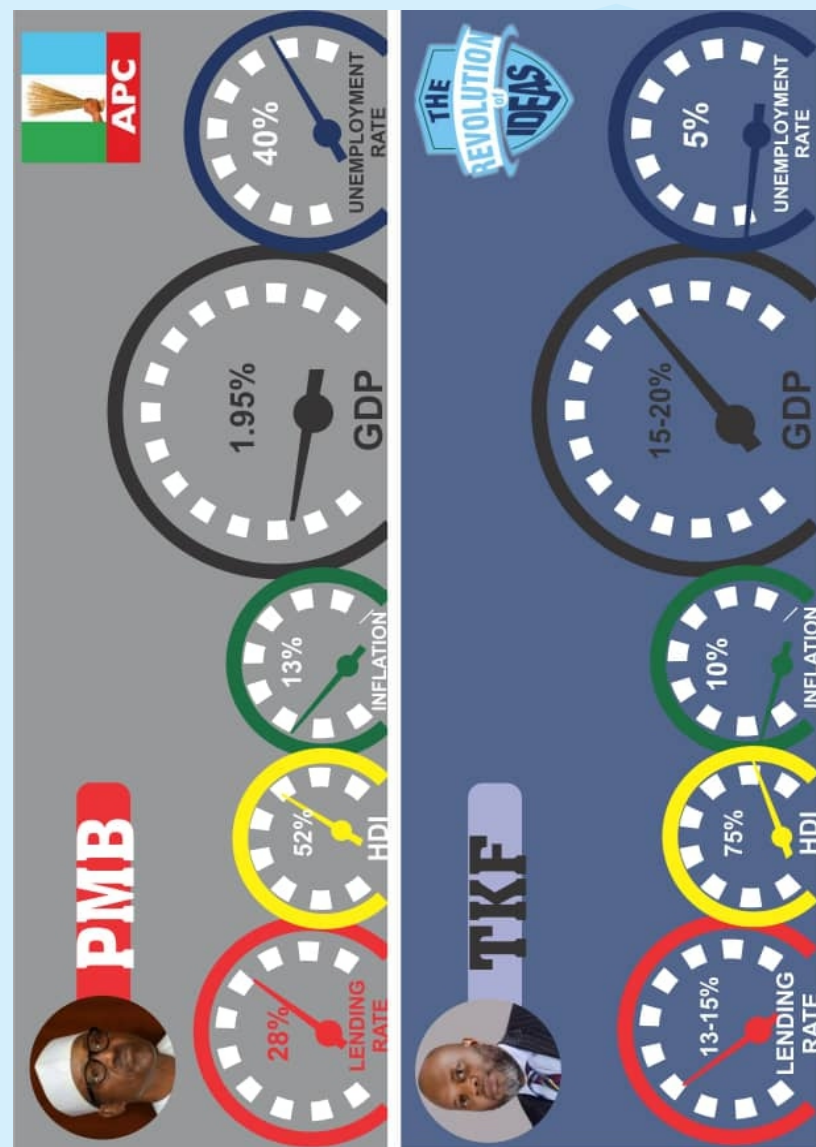

#### ITEMS TO BE TAKEN OFF “EXCLUSIVE LIST” - BUT WITH STATE COMMITMENT TO WORK WITH FG FOR THE RAPID DEVELOPMENT OF RURAL AREAS

1. Most of what is today called TRUNK ROADS. We need a redefinition of 'FEDERAL TRUNK ROADS'.
2. Littoral (shore states), should have an agreed limit of distance into the sea within which they can lay claim to mineral rights, including crude oil and other resources. I DON'T BELIEVE THAT A LITTORAL STATE OWNS ALL OF NIGERIA'S INTERNATIONAL WATERS.
3. Mining and Minerals - States to take control of these subject to environment and extraction taxes. Sector to be driven by private sector
4. POLICING - FG will keep most of its FEDERAL POLICE more like FBI. But states should have their own police. Creates more employment and better security.

5. PRISONS- States can have their own prisons and we decongest existing ones.
6. RAILWAYS - States like Lagos, Kano, Rivers have already breached this rule. METRO and Intra-state rail should be handled by states.
7. ELECTRICITY - We shall transit to cheap alternative energy and micro/mini grids with 100% local content and knowledge/innovation

#### THE FETCH INITIATIVE

Nigeria needs to press RESET. We will go back to DEFAULT MODE, as if we were just obtaining our colonial independence in 1960. Yes, they say a people need to revert to history in order to know where they must not head in the future; and how. The great poets say we need to identify 'where the rain began to beat us'. What should we have focused on, with the benefit of hindsight? Where should we have started from? How could we have proceeded from October 1st, 1960, in a way that showed inclusive growth, that spread our wealth, inspiration and opportunities to the furthest ends of our borders? How could we have prepared the grounds for unity, greatness, productivity, happiness, and respect from the world as well as mutual respect among ourselves? That is where we must start from. It is evident that we grossly missed our ways and are lost in the wilderness of despair, mistrust, insecurity, poverty, hunger, malnutrition and disease, and a

terrible dependency on other countries. These are what we must now reclaim. Nigeria has today, in the year 2018, become a country where rolling shanties have overtaken the entire landscape because of planlessness, greed, visionlessness, leaderlessness, myopia, disunity, sabotage, and a terribly low sense of self-worth. I am here to change this.

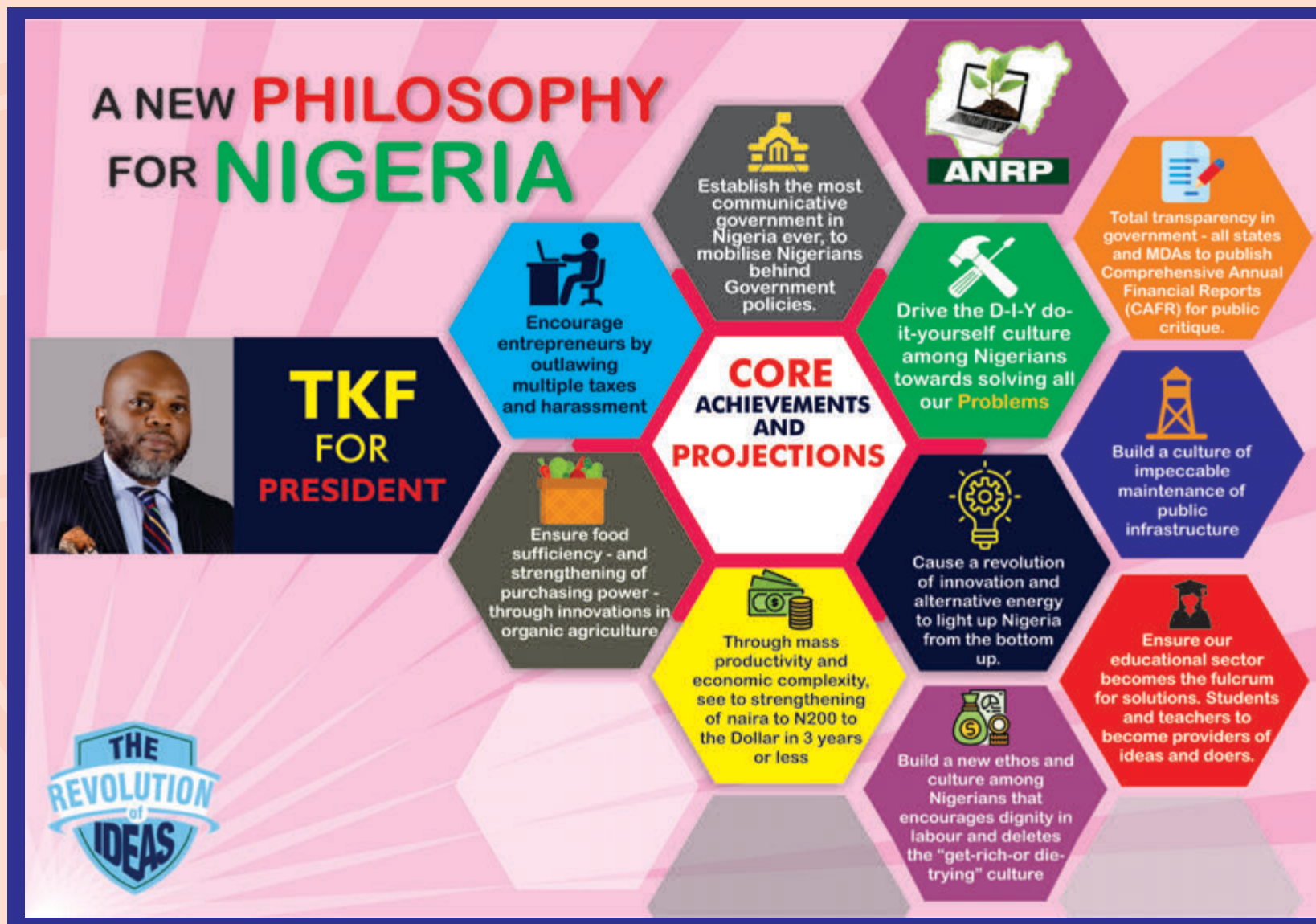
*I proceed from Chapter 2, Section 16 of our 1999 Constitution which states thus;*

#### CHAPTER 16.

- (1) The State shall, within the context of the ideals and objectives for which provisions are made in this Constitution.
  - (a) harness the resources of the nation and promote national prosperity and an efficient, a dynamic and self-reliant economy;
  - (b) control the national economy in such









manner as to secure the maximum welfare, freedom and happiness of every citizen on the basis of social justice and equality of status and opportunity;

- (c) without prejudice to its right to operate or participate in areas of the economy, other than the major sectors of the economy, manage and operate the major sectors of the economy;
- (d) without prejudice to the right of any person to participate in areas of the economy within the major sector of the economy, protect the right of every citizen to engage in any economic activities outside the major sectors of the economy.

(2) The State shall direct its policy towards ensuring:

- (a) the promotion of a planned and balanced economic development;
- (b) that the material resources of the nation are harnessed and distributed as best as possible to serve the common good;
- (c) that the economic system is not operated in such a manner as to permit the concentration of wealth or the means of production and exchange in the hands of few individuals or of a group; and
- (d) that suitable and adequate shelter, suitable and adequate food, reasonable

national minimum living wage, old age care and pensions, and unemployment, sick benefits and welfare of the disabled are provided for all citizens.

Therefore my **FIVE** core **EMERGENCIES** (which are borne out of a systems-thinking, pragmatic and interconnected approach to governance), for a necessary **RESET** and a **REVOLUTION** in the way we think and progress shall be to:

- Ensure Security in the nation (A vulnerable nation in a supersonic world of dynamic interest is waiting to be plucked like a duck. We will deploy our youthful assets in ensuring proper internal and external security all over the nation, especially in intelligence gathering. We will also start an urgent rebuilding of our military capabilities, from the ground up, using as much as possible of local resources and materials, and knowledge by tapping into our higher institutions and brains). **WE MUST SELL PATRIOTISM AMONG YOUNG NIGERIANS**

IRRESPECTIVE OF BACKGROUND, RELIGION, TRIBE OR CLAN.

- Food security (a food-poor country can never achieve greatness. Food must be healthy, plentiful and cheap in order to raise the real value of our currency and ensure our people's wages make sense to them. Agriculture is NOT only about business. It is life itself. It is about the survival of our nation. Emergency here)
- Tidy and beautify the nation (The worth of a people is seen from the way they value their physical environments. We shall urgently **OBSCESS** with our environment, by creating millions of sustainable jobs in sanitation, ambience-creation, creative arts, light environmental security, erosion-control, tree-planting, land reclamation, pollution control, oil-spill control, ending open defecation, sanitary education and enforcement, and tourism businesses. We shall immediately launch a program titled **CLEANEST, SAFEST,**





AND MOST-ORGANIZED COUNTRY IN AFRICA, to drive local and foreign TOURISM, as well as local and foreign direct investment)

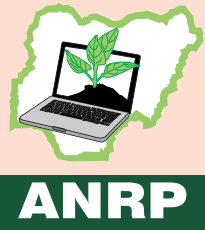
- Clothe the nation (A nation nudging 200million in population must necessarily clothe itself. Despite our endorsement of WTO Treaties, we shall immediately find ways of ensuring local capacity is built in the textile sector in order to conserve our financial resources and drastically reduce foreign importation. Tax rebates and other incentives will be granted to new and old textile firms such as to drive investment. In every industry we shall promote an infusion of young Nigerian trainees and interns for the purpose of revolutionizing our education system away from the acquisition of degrees, to the PROVISION OF HOME-GROWN SOLUTIONS to Nigeria's many problems).

NO PROVISIONS HAVE EVER BEEN MADE since the independence of Nigeria, leading to rolling slums and shanties ALL OVER the country. A housing revolution will tidy up the country and open a new vista in the attainment of self-worth among our people. No longer will people live in houses made of raw mud, or cellophane bags sewn together. This is the responsibility of government as it may not be profitable for the private sector. Where necessary, global aid funds can be assessed and deployed in this direction. Also, the Burnt Bricks industries across the nation could become viable if the prototypes for our village homes is to be made from processed mud bricks. The self-worth of Nigerians have been damaged because of the despicable and totally-unacceptable standard of living they have found themselves).

House the nation (We shall unleash a revolution in the provision of mass, lowest-income housing - consisting single rooms, one-bedrooms and two-bedroom flats - for the lowest income earners for whom

There are other areas of focus which are encompassed in the above 5 core focuses. The above however allows us begin to focus on the REAL DEVELOPMENT of our HUMAN RESOURCE and HUMAN CAPITAL. This 5 areas of focus are the CATALYSTS that will unleash value in every other sector. They represent an easy, relatable idea that we can explain to our masses, and a necessary level that we must pass before progressing to more complex issues.

Our people have been deliberately demented and mentally pulverized by machinated poverty, hunger and lack of opportunities. Our people have been blinded by unwarranted lack, confused, mentally maimed and annihilated by insecurity, devalued in the eyes of other peoples of the world by the filth, stench and environmental disasters in which they are forced to live, shamed by the nakedness in which millions of our children and adults dwell in an age of self-consciousness and aesthetics (for we are beamed to the world in this manner), and our people have been reduced to nothing due to their conditions of living. Solving these basic problems is our first port of call, and focusing on them allows us to build capacity in other areas such as our Educational System, our Industrial Capabilities, among others. Moreover, a focus on the FETCH initiative does not require massive amounts of capital. It's about using what we have to get what we want, and starting immediately. A

restoration of dignity in, and an appreciation of a new vision which empowers our people is the very sine qua non for the kind of productivity we need to unleash immediately. It is absolutely imperative to totally release this country back to its youths - not only in political terms, but more importantly in every productive sector.

## SECTORIAL INITIATIVES

Below are some of our sectorial initiatives:

**HOUSING** - "Rural Renewal", not just urban renewal. We will stem the rural-urban drift and focus on VERY low income housing. We shall end the spread of shanties and slums. Re-humanize AND RE-DIGNIFY OUR PEOPLE. Like other progressive countries, we must activate the SOCIAL HOUSING clause in our national constitution. We shall halt the mistake of building luxury houses which most Nigerians cannot afford and which lie fallow today.

**WATER** - We have to fix our water systems OURSELVES. We shall go back to our universities/polytechnics and incentivize/challenge students and academia to come up with solutions to this crisis. Nigeria recently obtained a 54million Euros loan from HUNGARY, meant for research into water and flooding. We

can definitely handle water ourselves. Our first tertiary institution was established in 1948. We have churned out graduates ever since. We will handle this. We will provide potable water all over the country, and use innovative ways to distribute to our people where the infrastructure has broken down.

**WOMEN** - All positions in government are open to women. Women are smarter and in many ways stronger in my humble opinion. I commit to 50% affirmative action. We are sure Nigerian women can no longer be held down

**YOUTHS** - All positions open to them. ONLY the Youths have the energy, passion and global networks and TECH SAVVINESS to take Nigeria forward and catch up with other progressive countries. My government shall be powered by well-balanced youths. And we shall ensure endless opportunities for the youths so that our adults may rest.

**ENERGY** - The solution to our energy/power problem is again internal. Our Universities and Polytechnics will have to take the lead. We will mainstream ALTERNATIVE ENERGY and use this opportunity to rejig the importance of the educational sector. Rather than continual investments into a grid that leaks 2,000mw in 'stranded power' daily, we will empower and fund engineering departments to take as hands-on

projects and get very practical by lighting up villages and small towns around them. This takes the pressure off the National Grid. Also, high-end homes in large cities will be mandated to install alternative energy systems such as solar and inverters so that we have more power to channel to factories, and some for our low income population. No approvals for 4 bedroom houses and above, shall be granted without a clear alternative energy plan incorporated in the drawings and prototypes. I PREDICT that just like the GSM revolution took telephony in leaps and bounds in Africa, cheap alternatives and microgrids are the ways forward for Nigeria

**EDUCATION** - This is the fulcrum of development. We will focus education on socioeconomic development. We will declare immediate EMERGENCY on the situation where 15million Nigerian children are out of school. This is 100 years of this country MORTGAGED and is the biggest existential challenge we have as a people. Any parent who rejects COMPULSORY BASIC EDUCATION for their children shall be strongly counseled and recalcitrant ones prosecuted as prescribed by the constitution. We will also appeal to community leaders to make this a reality. Our secondary and tertiary institutions will be recalibrated to solve problems, not just for the issuance of certificates. Education will become practical in the main. Students from secondary level





will be focused on writing papers on solutions within their areas and practicalizing solutions. A body will be set up to review all projects, theses and dissertations from all higher institutions, in order to sieve out the best proposals and use them with reference to the researcher. Focus will be on Jobs for Secondary Sch leavers, who will be supervised by university graduates. As obtains in other countries, tertiary institution students will be encouraged to do light work and combine with schooling. We will work towards returning Public Schools, even if we have to adopt the approach of giving many back to the initial clergies (muslim and christian) which established them.

relevant and renew our villages. 1,000,000 public service jobs can be created if we employ 10 youths in each ward across the below areas of essential services. We will keep a tight control on performance using biometrics. We shall continue to encourage entrepreneurship but ensure people have purchasing power. JOBS FOR YOUTH IN ENVIRONMENT SECTOR, PARAMILITARY, STATISTICS/ DATA GATHERING, LIGHT SECURITY, INTELLIGENCE SERVICES HEALTH SECTOR, EDUCATION (TEACHERS), MASS MOBILIZATION, ORIENTATION AGENCY, TRANSPORT SECTOR, BEAUTIFYING OUR ENVIRONMENT, TREE-PLANTING, ARTISTS TO DECORATE OUR PUBLIC

**JOB CREATION** - Rejig and overhaul, and clean up our S M A L L , T O P - HEAVY, and TOXIC PUBLIC SERVICE which has become a bastion for fraud and greed and where almost all budget items are owned by insiders who are also paid by the country. Post young people to villages to be

FACILITIES, CONTROLLERS OF EROSION. WASTE RECYCLING SYSTEM AND PROMOTION OF AN ORGANIC NIGERIA. There is money to pay for these new workers if only a few greedy people will not cream it off through bogus infrastructure projects. OECD Countries employ an average of 21% of all workers in PUBLIC SECTOR (to provide basic amenities that ensure good living for their people). Britain employs 21% of its working population IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR. USA employs 18%. Norway employs 35% of its working population in the public sector. Nigeria ranks among failing countries which have less than 5% of their workers in the public sector, but a vast majority which are not patriotic and cream off 50% of the annual budget. Job Creation is absolutely critical for a country such as ours with a youth bulge and largely undertrained people. I note that the private sector IS NOT IN THE BUSINESS OF CREATING JOBS, but in maximizing profits using as little resources as possible, especially human resources. I note that the drive for private sector employment generation needs a fillip, which is responsibility from the government and public sector. That is why despite all the calls and programs and drive towards entrepreneurship, Nigeria still suffers up to 65% youth employment. The responsibility of ensuring FULL EMPLOYMENT for a working population rests squarely with the GOVERNMENT. All else is self-deception. This imperative is more

poignant as we live in the age of Artificial Intelligence where robots are replacing humans by the droves. WE MUST ACT WITH SPEED. WE HAVE SLACKED OUT FOR TOO LONG ON THIS CRUCIAL ISSUE. There is another problem with the PUBLIC SERVICE and that is PAY DISPARITY between core civil servants and those in 'lucky' liquid parastatals. This is a good justification for salary increases. We note that the ultra high salaries in the lucky parastatals have not reduce the likelihood for corruption in them. We are ready to bring this to the front burner as we presently operate an unfair system. We shall unify salary structures give or take a disparity of 15%, within 4 years.

Health sector - Mass training and recruitment of health assistants, who will function for first aid and administration while we strive to reverse the brain drain that sucks all our medical doctors, pharmacists and senior health workers abroad. A functioning health centre will be available in all villages. We shall also employ Health Education experts - to train our people on hygiene and thereby reduce public health bill.

AGRICULTURE - Amplify the role of science in seed and yield improvements. Assist subsistence farmers for better productivity and manage transition to mechanization. We must urgently coach our subsistence farmers on ways of

maximizing crop productivity. New, improved seeds must mainstream all over the nation. Promote commodity boards or clustering for price stability. Agric productivity no longer relies on land mass. Through the further 'scientification' of agriculture, we shall ensure no Nigerian remains food hungry, and where possible, we shall provide for other African countries, and ensure food is very cheap in a way that the Naira is 'strengthened' when basic income is able to cover food needs of families twice over. Focus remains on organic food, and health is emphasized. Unlike in other countries where food is cheap, we will ensure that this does not result in health issues for the poorest by providing mass education around food, nutrition and good health. It's all work, work, work.

Science and Technology - STEM Education will be emphasized for we have to make what we need ourselves. Science is central to the success of our strategy to provide for ourselves by beginning to get a handle on small technology while scaling up. This also ties up with our educational revolution. For example, we will start our student-led



power/energy revolution by lighting up villages and scaling up.

History and Sociology - This study of history and sociology will be a must for primary, secondary schools and higher institutions. We must learn about and appreciate ourselves. A number of challenges we face results from the pervading ignorance in the land about sociological and historical issues. We shall cause to be prepared and circulated, an anthropological map of Nigeria which should show our cultural relatedness and the difficulty we will have in splitting into disparate parts.

**Security/Defence** - Most of our INSECURITY problems are intelligence-based. To be tackled by youth involvement and employment into intelligence, paramilitary, and light security work. Our youths will do this job with dignity and secure their neighborhoods. A systemic overhaul of intelligence services will be carried out and several layers of checks and balances instituted to ensure sabotage/espionage is eliminated. We shall start rebuilding our capabilities to provide our own weaponry rather than the 100% reliance on foreign countries which comes with attendant delays, compromises and vulnerabilities

**Solid minerals, Aviation and other business sectors** - Most sectors will be run on a strictly business basis. Private sector players will be encouraged to invest subject to smart and tight negotiations for the Nigerian people. We shall be business-friendly, tech-driven but ensure strict tax compliance. Some critical, upcoming sectors shall get tax rebates for employing Nigerians, for being startups for technology transfer. Solid mineral rights that are on shore, and in an agreed minimal distance into Nigeria's territorial waters, shall be vested in state governments who will then put into effect concessions which favour the residents of their states according to Chapter 2, section 16 of our constitution. Deep sea assets shall be vested in the Federal Government

**Transport** - Within 3 years, ensure ALL state capitals are connected by passenger and cargo rail to reduce pressure on road transport. Improvement in internal revenue will be emphasized to fund this transport revolution, not endless borrowing. Through scientific collaborations, evolve new materials that will ensure our roads don't fall apart every year. Overhaul road maintenance and make it more nimble and quick. Roads don't have to collapse before interventions. Overhaul FERMA or merge back to Ministry of Works. ALL top government personnel will be encouraged to use the roads so that they feel the pains of the people and so that the roads will always receive urgent attention. The involvement of millions of youths in light security and paramilitary and intelligence work, will reduce carnage, kidnappings and robberies on our roads. We shall MAINSTREAM Inland Waterways in all major cities that are so endowed. We shall appeal for unity among our regional leaders to achieve this. We shall dredge Rivers Niger and Benue in spite of all opposition to this great, unifying idea and ensure major cities along the rivers are connected by ferries for the movement of people and goods. This takes pressure of the roads. We cannot be defined by our terrible roads. They are NOT our destiny.

**Justice** - Our judicial system is problematic. On the side of enforcement is the police, which has

become an instrument of oppression, in spite of its embedded capabilities. Nigerian Police has well-trained officers. But the Force has been dehumanised. First is to withdraw police from private duties. Another corps can be provided for that, which will be paid for by those who need them and all payments TOTALLY accounted for by those in charge. This is another revenue source for government. We project about half a trillion Naira in yearly revenue from this. Our judges and magistrates need help. Record keeping will be digitized as part of our tech focus. Dispensing justice will be quick and cases will not atrophy due to our reforms. There will be total clampdown on corruption in our court system. Judges are seen as God's representative on earth given the powers of life and death they possess. It is the worst tragedy if judges are corruptible as we have seen in Nigeria. Judges' salaries will be equated with what obtains in some of our 'lucky' parastatals.

**PETROLEUM and GAS**- WE SHALL BRING BACK THE REAL PIB. EMPHASIS WILL BE ON INCREASING NIGERIA'S SHARE OF SIGNATURE AND PRODUCTION BONUSES, ROYALTIES AND PETROLEUM PROFIT TAX. SOME OF OUR AGREEMENTS WITH IOCs IN THIS SECTOR ARE DATED 1960. OUR PRODUCTION SHARING CONTRACTS (PSCs) HAVE SEEN NIGERIA THOROUGHLY HOODWINKED AND CHEATED BY



SMART OIL COMPANIES. THIS IS THE CORE REASON ANGOLA IS BUDGETING \$56billion FOR 25MILLION CITIZENS THIS YEAR WHILE NIGERIA CAN ONLY MANAGE \$25Billion for 180 million people. How did Angola do it? We shall use diplomacy and the best negotiation and technical skills to handle this tricky business. But Nigeria cannot continue to suffer under our watch. We shall strike deals for the ending of gas flaring through the conversion of gas to power and fuel. We shall continue to develop internal capacity in this sector, beyond soft skills, but in the fabrication of some of the very expensive equipment.

**SPORTS** - Redevelop sports beyond football. Refocus on nutrition for our children. Encourage all regions of Nigeria to compete for participation at all international meets. Develop and redevelop at least 20 other Olympic sports (long and short distance athletics, swimming, boxing etc). Promote secondary schools sports competition around the country, as well as Universities, Polytechnics, Colleges, Police, Army and similar games. We commit to building sports centers in every small town all over the nation, to harness and develop the energy and talents of our young patriots.



## OTHER AREAS OF EMPHASIS

### FIRST, ECONOMIC RESTRUCTURING

WE SHALL INSTITUTE A PROCESS OF ECONOMIC RESTRUCTURING, A PRECURSOR TO ANY OTHER TYPE OF RESTRUCTURING. FOCUS IS ON ECONOMICS AND BETTER LIFE AND IMPROVED HUMANITY FOR OUR PEOPLE

According to Walter Rodney:

“A society develops economically as its members increase jointly their capacity for dealing with the environment. This capacity for DEALING WITH THE ENVIRONMENT, is dependent on the extent to which they understand the laws of nature (science), on the extent to which they put that understanding into practice by devising tools (technology), and on the manner in which work is organized.”

The above will guide a structured approach to development for us. We believe that we must concentrate on socioeconomic development more



than anything else. The focus shall be on INTERNALIZING our development quest and understanding it is totally our responsibility and no one else's. We have to therefore understand fully how to deal with our social, political, economic and physical environments, then proceed to understand how we shall devise intellectual, physical, sociopolitical and other tools to give us a better life and help us out of quagmires. Finally, we shall by ourselves assess our human resources to understand how to best use this greatest resource, how too increase our productivity, and how to ensure our youths do not lay about waiting for the devil to send them on errands.





As regards issues surrounding derivation and ownership of resources, I believe state governors should not attempt to constitute themselves into sovereigns and monarchs by a process of power-grab. We can institute unique checks and balances for our peculiar system. Rather than have a state governor with the power of life and death over resources, we should be thinking of joint committees that will allow flow of resources to as many Nigerians as possible. If this can be assured, I believe more control of resources should be immediately afforded to states, local governments, ward and peoples at the grassroots.

### ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION

First, we must properly separate the need to diversify government sources of revenue, from diversifying (or restructuring) the entire economy as a whole. The areas into which I expect to look for additional revenue for government are captured below and include tourism, solid minerals, more compliance with taxes, fees, fines, rates, duties and levies that are currently being flouted at will, and a general organization of our society like other peoples have done. Nigeria has enough laws which specify the revenue that is due to each level of government. The reality is that each of those laws are being observed in the breach. The 'do-you-know-who-i-am?' syndrome is undoing Nigeria as

lawmakers are also lawbreakers. We will deliberately go after those who are in government and have flouted Nigeria's laws, as examples as is being done elsewhere. If people see government officials, politicians and top civil servants being held to account, they will conform with the laws of the land and revenues will rise

But the **REAL DIVERSIFICATION** of the economy is in ensuring the interdependence of each sector on other sectors. It is in ensuring that we keep our money within the family and that whatever Nigerians need can be bought from another Nigerian, and should be made from materials, ideas, technology, concepts, knowledge and innovations that are **MADE IN NIGERIA**. The only way to know how to diversify a whole economy is to look at an economy that we know to be diversified. In the final analysis, a diversified economy is one which is self-dependent, but successful in playing the globalization and free-trade game. While we concentrate on producing the basics that we need - as captured in the **FETCH** gambit - we will rapidly proceed in producing **COMPLEX GOODS** that can command value in global markets. We shall never compete properly if we focus on primary goods, and the **COMPARATIVE ADVANTAGE** argument has been found to promote laziness, and to box economies into conundrums. We shall do much more than our comparative advantages dictate.

### SOCIO-POLITICAL RESTRUCTURING

Nigeria has arrived at the point where we have to accede to some sociopolitical restructuring such as state policing. We cannot keep whipping out the bogeyman that governors will turn them against their enemies. However we shall be reviewing the system of security votes which state governors use as slush fund. This shall be taken to the court of the people. I believe that such funds should be properly oversighted and released to the structure of state policing once the idea is brought on board. I believe that restructuring should be a constant thing for any society, as societies should review the efficiency of their systems from time to time. Nothing should be static and permanent to the extent that they become burdens on society. However, geopolitical restructuring - which entails cutting Nigeria into pieces or giving the right to secede to constituent parts should be approached with great caution. I believe that if the economy works well and for the benefit of the majority, the current anger and disappointment will not drive the process. Geographic restructuring, if propelled by anger, will lead to a cataclysmic implosion of Nigeria; it will result in the very end and a protracted internecine crisis.

FAAC TO 25%, down from 56%.

I propose this new Revenue Sharing Formula:

Federal Government	-	25%
State Governments	-	35%
Local Governments	-	40%

This inverts what we have presently. Because of the experience whereby governors emasculate the LGs, and since we know that our next SPURT OF GROWTH WILL COME FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, I propose a joint committee management and planning for the 40% which goes to the LGs. That committee will have representation from all tiers of government. This will also help with expertise for the increased level of attention and funding at the LG and Ward levels. Development MUST percolate to the nooks and crannies of Nigeria

If we are to fund \$35bn out of our proposed \$40bn budget in 2019/2020, which translates presently to N12.6Trillion, we can generate funds from these broad areas:

These estimates are based on simulation from what obtains in other countries with similar structure and resources. We believe that of those countries could generate a lot more revenue than Nigeria presently, the first thing to do is try and catch up. Nigeria is meant to be the largest economy in Africa. This fact MUST show up in our revenue profile and budgeting. The current scenario is that most of Nigeria's revenue goes into private pockets, due to tardiness on the part of revenue agencies, corruption, a failure to appreciate how society should work, and what is called powerful 'vested interests' who have refused to keep their ends of the social bargain.. We will extract our commonwealth from those pockets.

Some of the above revenues will be statutorily shared with other levels of government. Others - like CGT - at the level of corporates, belong to the FG. These projections are also driven by a revolutionary reordering of society, an improvement in purchasing power among all Nigerians, which improves company profitability and attracts local

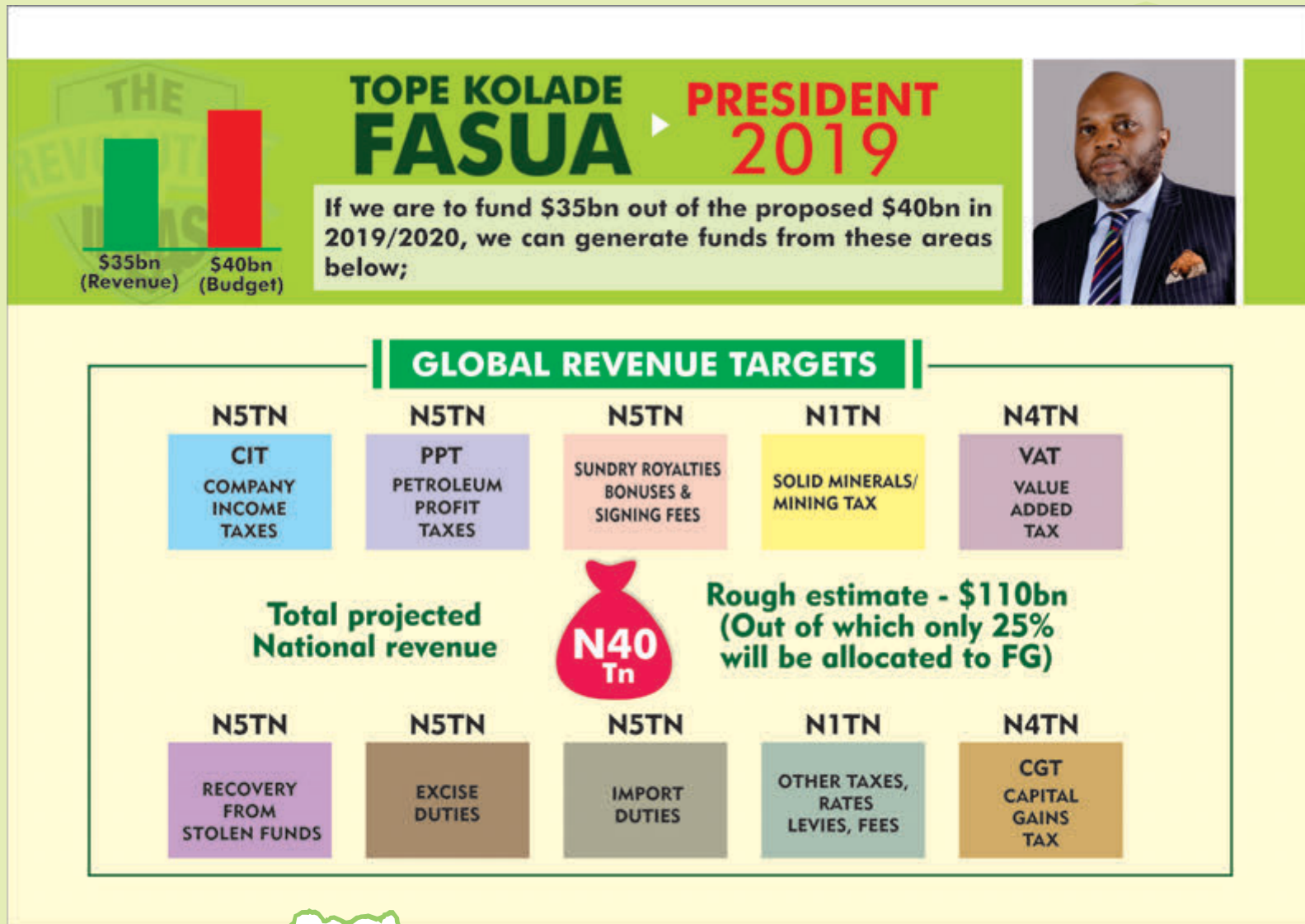

The current toxic regime where we bicker painfully over so little will be immediately banished. There is ABUNDANCE IN NIGERIA. ANRP is the party that recognizes that.

A serious, thinking, smart, patriotic and visionary government is what I have in mind. We shall eradicate reckless political horse-trading by which the country has been gutted. The first step to drive up revenue is to show honesty, integrity and frugality in government circles and improve taxpayer confidence. Also we must not readily capitulate to requests for waivers powered by political favours. We must be ready to put all statutory taxes on the table and drive compliance - eg inheritance taxes. We will FOLLOW THE MONEY into everywhere it goes and ensure government gets its fair and modest share.

### TAXATION

Taxes will not be too high as they needn't be punitive. Payability is a requirement for good taxation. Company income taxes shall be marginally reduced. VAT will be maintained at 5% because for now government collects from all sides as against waiting for net remittance. 3-years tax

waivers will be granted to new businesses in the areas of focus - food, clothing, very low-cost shelter, recycling, environmental management, youth-focused, labour intensive businesses. However ALL such businesses must show ability to pay minimum wage of N30,000 for lowest-level staff for the next 3 years and ensure no single complaints come from their staff to that effect. Many private companies in Nigeria are known to owe staff for months and years and just refuse to pay but wait for the staff to get frustrated and leave on their own (so much for private sector employment generation). The push for entrepreneurship (go-and-start-your-own-business), is being used as a crutch for government to escape their responsibilities.

### NAIRA VALUE

With stability achieved in the Macroeconomy, and self-sufficiency taking hold, plus attitudinal change being achieved, we can begin to revalue the Naira via the interaction of market forces, toward N200 to \$1. This is important to assist our MANUFACTURING SECTOR and other importers of technology and productive materials who desire to set up in Nigeria and expand their operations. The strength of a currency also signals the sustainability of its economy. Whereas our economy is not strong enough to compete at par with the US Economy, or

indeed any OECD economy, it is important to begin this hard reset. As Margaret Thatcher once quipped, to ruin a country, first debauch it's currency. The Naira is current debauched, and must be un-debauched, by a combination of agile, nimble, patriotic, productive, visionary policies. The focus must first be on our self-sufficiency before the elusive export.

### BUDGETING

- . Performance-based/zero-based budgeting to be given full effect

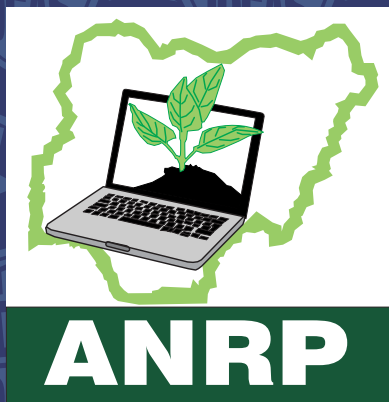
